Personal/non-commercial use

No copyright permission request is necessary from original authors posting a **pre-published* version of their article** on their own web site or uploading it to institutional and/or centrally organized repositories. In this case the article must include the following statement:

This article is not an exact copy of the original published article in *[journal title]*. The definitive publisher-authenticated version of *[insert complete citation information here]* is available online at: *[insert URL here]*.

The original author is also allowed to include the article in a thesis or dissertation provided that this is not to be published commercially.

Posting and uploading of the **copy-edited version** is allowed only **after a 12 month embargo period** after the publishing date.
