Supplementary Table 1: Sedation and anaesthetic techniques used

Sedation	Intravenous injection of medetomidine (0.01 mg/kg) and butorphanol (0.1mg/kg)
General anaesthesia	Premedication: Medetomidine (0.003mg/kg), and methadone (0.02mg/kg). Induction: Propofol (2mg/kg IV) Maintained: Isoflurane in oxygen.
Epidural analgesia	Bupivacaine (20mg) and morphine (2mg) Perioperative intravenous antibiotics of cefuroxime (20mg/kg)
