Use of copyrighted material always requires proper citation.

Personal/non-commercial use

1. No copyright permission request is necessary from original authors posting a **submitted**, but not yet accepted version of their manuscript ("pre-print") on their own website or uploading it to institutional and/or centrally organized repositories, including any social networking site or platform (e. g. ResearchGate, Mendeley).
2. Authors may post an **accepted**, but not yet typeset and edited version of their manuscript ("post-print") on their own website or upload it to institutional and/or centrally organized repositories, including any social networking site or platform (e. g. ResearchGate, Mendeley), only after a 12-month embargo period after the publishing date.
In case of other requirements by your funding agencies please contact the publisher at Carola.Kalff@Schattauer.de. It is not allowed to use this version commercially or to disseminate it systematically.
3. In both cases the article must include the following statement: "This article is not an exact copy of the original published article in (journal title). The definitive publisher-authenticated version of (insert complete citation information here) is available online at: (insert URL here)."
4. It is **not allowed** to use the typeset and edited version of the published article (**Publisher version**) to post it on the author's own website or to upload it to institutional and/or centrally organized repositories, including any social networking site or platform (e. g. ResearchGate, Mendeley).
5. However, the original author is allowed to use the Publisher version for teaching purposes. The Author may also forward the Publisher version to a small number of colleagues, and include it in a thesis or dissertation provided that this is not to be published commercially.
